The prefecture of Ishikawa boasts its own history of arts and culture, with a tradition of *Hogaku*, or classical Japanese music, that extends back to the days of feudal *Kaga* Domain. The Orchestra Ensemble Kanazawa has performed as a collaboration between these different musical cultures. The selected new piece will be performed by Orchestra Ensemble Kanazawa with Noh-Dance in the *Wayo-no Hibiki III* Concert on 12 February 2023.

We are looking for the apply from young composer extensively and we will be expecting the new work appropriate for the moment when new culture is born.

TERM / CONDITION

- 1. Number of Winner** One Person
- 2. Theme** Orchestral Music with Noh-Dance
- 3. Eligibility** 40 Years old or younger
- 4. Application Period** From 1 September 2022 to 30 September 2022
- 5. Work** The work must be unpublished, and incorporated 1 or 2 Japanese instrument(s). The Work should be friendly to public and be around 7 minutes in length.
- 6. Instrumentation** [Selectable Japanese Instruments]

- 7. Musical Notation** The work must be written on five-line staff. Annotated edition in Japanese or English is required if using unpopular notes and symbols.
